Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7 | NIV | gratitude worry

This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us. 1 John 5:14 | NIV | trust listening

Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful. Colossians 4:2 | NIV | gratitude

Therefore I tell you, whatever you ask for in prayer, believe that you have received it, and it will be yours. Mark 11:24 | NIV | faith receiving

Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. Jeremiah 29:12 | NIV | worship listening

Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. Romans 12:12 | NIV | joy patience

And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. Matthew 6:7 | NIV | speaking

'Call to me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know.' Jeremiah 33:3 | NIV | understanding listening

Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need. Hebrews 4:16 | NIV | mercy In my distress I called to the Lord; I cried to my God for help. From his temple he heard my voice; my cry came before him, into his ears. Psalm 18:6 | NIV | speaking listening

But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you. Matthew 6:6 | NIV | reward The Father

But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. James 1:6 | NIV | trust faith

Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. James 5:16 | NIV | righteousness healing

And if we know that he hears us—whatever we ask—we know that we have what we asked of him. 1 John 5:15 | NIV | trust listening

But to you who are listening I say: Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you. Luke 6:27-28 | NIV | obedience blessing

About midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening to them. Acts 16:25 | NIV | worship listening

They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with his brothers. Acts 1:14 | NIV | community

The end of all things is near. Therefore be alert and of sober mind so that you may pray. 1 Peter 4:7 | NIV | second coming rest

You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last—and so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you. John 15:16 | NIV | obedience calling
