Ingredients— a substance that forms part of a mixture

Process— a series of actions or steps taken in order to achieve a particular end

Journey— a traveling from one place to another, usually taking a rather long time; trip

<u>ISOLATE</u> – to pull away, single out, avoid the company of others, quarantine, to keep away from. (INTROVERTS)

SEPARATE – to stop being mixed together, to make a distinction between two things, set part, severe ties, segregate, divide, detached, no longer associated, go in two different directions (holy, sanctified)

_____Pharisees took this to another level

And brought about legalism and religious control

MODERATE – avoiding extremes of behavior, establishing reasonable limits,

LIBERATE – to be freed from someone or something else's control, to be unchained, or released from outside domination, dominion (Satan, sin, death, lies, addiction, religion)

<u>INTEGRATE</u> – to desegregate, and include, blend something small into something larger. (EXTROVERTS)

to find people far from God and bring them close to Christ. (with people outside the church, we go to them in order to bring them where we are)

Mark 1: ³⁵ Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where he prayed

James 4: ⁴ You adulterous people don't you know that friendship with the world means enmity against God? Therefore, anyone who chooses to be a friend of the world becomes an enemy of God.

2 Cor 6: 4 Do not be yoked together with unbelievers. For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common?
