- 1. God spoke His word to Moses on Mt Sinai in about 1500 BC.
- 2. The first 5 books of the Bible are known as the Pentateuch
- When the Pentateuch is found on a scroll it is called a Torah.
- 4. The 39 books of the Old Test were completed around 500 BC
- The Greek New Testament was written on Papyrus (crushed plant)
- 6. In 393 AD, the African Synod of Hipo confirmed the books to be included in the New Testament.
- 7. In 500 AD the Bible was translated into over 500 languages.
- In 600 AD the Bible was only allowed in 1 language- Latin. If you had any other, you could be executed.
- 9. A thousand years between 400 AD and 1400 AD were known as the dark ages because truth was kept from the masses.
- 10. The Reformation was born out of a 700 year Bible study.
- 11. Wycliffe would spend 10 months to translate the Bible into another language,
- 12. The Pope had Wycliffe's bones dug up and spread across the river to make a statement renouncing him and his work.
- 13. John Hus was a heretic burned at the stake with Wycliffe's Bibles for fuel.
- 14. Luther wrote 95 accusations of heresy against the Catholic church.
- 15. Luther used the Gutenberg printing press to distribute his teaching and translation of the Bible.
- 16. In 1526 Tyndale was friends with Luther. He printed the first english Bible which was illegal and ran from the law for 11 years. He was burned at the stake.
- 17. The Bible is the best selling book of all time and the most shoplifted.
- 18. The Bible would take about 70 hours to be read aloud.

- 19. The Bible was written by politicians, statesmen, farmers, shepherds, peasants, musicians, poets, doctors and tax collectors.
- 20. The Bible was written in 13 different countries.
- 21. It took 1500 years to write the Bible.
- 22. In 1952 there were 3 tests to prove accuracy of the Bible. Internal were there witnesses? External test do other sources confirm it? Bibliographic test how well were the original manuscripts copied?
- 23. The New Testament was written between 47 and 95 AD.
- 24. Archeology has confirmed hundreds of Bible stories, and none have disproved them.
- 25. The dead sea scrolls were found in 1947 and written / hidden in about 70 AD; preserved for about 2,000 years.
- 26. Homer had 643 written copies, the most of any secular writing. The Bible has 24,000 written copies.
- 27. 2,000 prophecies have been fulfilled in scripture, 500 more will happen in the end times.
