worship music -

In the early church, believers sang from the Psalms and were accompanied by music. The New Testament even says that the disciples sang hymns (Matt 26:30). As religious church services became more organized and formal, the music took on more of a ritual characteristic. Responsive singing, like echoes, preceded the style known as chants. Pope Gregory created the first written chants and were thus called "Gregorian chants". In the middle ages, special Catholic Masses were held seasonally to celebrate certain feasts called "Holy" days. This was the birth of the cantada. The singing became more rehearsed and performance oriented as the congregation became spectators. Soon afterwards the pipe organ became popular in religious worship. Many are still used in today's churches including the world's largest. It is 64 feet long with over 30,000 pipes and cost \$105 million dollars.

²¹ So I find this law at work: Although I want to do good, evil is right there with me. ²² For in my inner being I delight in God's law; ²³ but I see another law at work in me, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within me. ²⁴ What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body that is subject to death? ²⁵ Thanks be to God, who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!

Future (Glorification) Rom 5:9 - But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. ⁹ Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him! ¹⁰ For if, while we were God's enemies, we were reconciled to him through the death of his Son, how much more, having been reconciled, shall we be saved through his life!
