Acts 17:22,28 - Paul then stood up in the meeting of the Areopagus and

23 For as I walked around and looked carefully at your objects of worship, I
even found an altar with this inscription: to an unknown god. So you are
ignorant of the very thing you worship—and this is what I am going to

proclaim to you. **24** "The God who made the world and everything in it is the
Lord of heaven and earth and does not live in temples built by human
hands. **25** And he is not served by human hands, as if he needed anything.

Rather, he himself gives everyone life and breath and everything else.

26 From one man he made all the nations, that they should inhabit the

whole earth; and he marked out their appointed times in history and the boundaries of their lands. **27** God did this so that they would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from any one of us. **28** 'For in him we live and move and have our being.' As some of your own poets have said, 'We are his offspring.

Occult -

1 Sam 28: Now Samuel was dead, and all Israel had mourned for him and buried him in his own town of Ramah. Saul had expelled the mediums and spiritists from the land. **4** The Philistines assembled and came and set up camp at Shunem, while Saul gathered all Israel and set up camp at Gilboa. **5** When Saul saw the Philistine army, he was afraid; terror filled his heart. **6** He inquired of the Lord, but the Lord did not answer him by dreams or Urim or prophets. **7** Saul then said to his attendants, "Find me a woman who is a medium, so I may go and inquire of her." "There is one in Endor," they said.

8 So Saul disguised himself, putting on other clothes, and at night he and two men went to the woman. "Consult a spirit for me," he said, "and bring up for me the one I name."

9 But the woman said to him, "Surely you know what Saul has done. He has cut off the mediums and spiritists from the land. Why have you set a trap for my life to bring about my death?"

Leviticus 20:6 -

"I will set my face against anyone who turns to mediums and spiritists to prostitute themselves by following them, and I will cut them off from their people.

Deut 18:11,12 -

Let no one be found among you who sacrifices their son or daughter in the fire, who practices divination or sorcery, interprets omens, engages in witchcraft, **11** or casts spells, or who is a medium or spiritist or who consults the dead. **12** Anyone who does these things is detestable to the Lord;

Leviticus 19:31 -

'Do not turn to mediums or seek out spiritists, for you will be defiled by them. I am the Lord your God.

2 Kings 23:24 -

Furthermore, Josiah got rid of the mediums and spiritists, the household gods, the idols and all the other detestable things seen in Judah and Jerusalem. This he did to fulfill the requirements of the law written in the book that Hilkiah the priest had discovered in the temple of the Lord.
