

## WICCA - polytheistic

God (male) Goddess (female) also known as the moon goddess and the horned God. but no central authority, possible pantheistic (everything equal to god)

male counterpart is for fertilization, female “gives birth”

she can be named Dianna, Helena (as in the greek goddesses) or mother nature.

at one with all living things, plants, animals, people  
embraces evolution, Karma, and reincarnation

pagan witchcraft - claims only to use positive forces, never placing a curse

performs annual splurge which includes “sweeping” negative feelings, spirits from ones house by burning SAGE and using a broom.

teaching varies from group to group just like christian denominations

no belief in Satan but does believe in evil and demons

a coven meets for prayer meetings

Rituals include - a staged sacred circle where witches and warlocks cast spells for healing, protection, fertility, or banish negative influences. Magic is used as a manipulative force through the practice of witchcraft and sorcery. Reincarnation allows for the use of a medium to contact dead spirits.
