GHOST – 1 THE PRESENCE OF THE HOLY

2 Now the earth was formless and empty, darkness was over the surface of the deep, and the <u>Spirit of God</u> was hovering over the waters. Genesis 1:2

ruwach (roo'-akh); wind; breath, a violent exhalation; blast of breath.

pneuma (pnyoo'-mah); a current of air, blast of breath, a strong breeze; or spirit.

And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another <u>Counselor</u> to be with you forever- 17 the <u>Spirit of truth</u>. The world cannot accept him, because it neither <u>sees him</u> nor <u>knows him</u>. But you know him, for he <u>lives with</u> <u>you</u> and will be <u>in you</u>. John 14:16-17

Counselor: parakletos (par-ak'-lay-tos); an intercessor, consoler, advocate, comforter, helper.

But it is actually <u>best for you</u> that I go away, because if I don't, the Counselor won't come. If I do go away, he will come because I will send him to you. John 16:7 NLT

WHY ARE MANY LIVING A SPIRIT-LESS LIFE?

• SOME AREN'T AWARE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.

While Apollos was at Corinth, Paul took the road through the interior and arrived at Ephesus. There he found some disciples 2 and asked them, "Did you receive the Holy Spirit when you believed?" They answered, "No, we have not even heard that there is a Holy Spirit." Acts 19:1-3

• SOME <u>RESIST</u> THE HOLY SPIRIT.

"You stiff-necked people, with uncircumcised hearts and ears! You are just like your fathers: You always <u>resist</u> the Holy Spirit! Acts 7:51

THE HOLY SPIRIT WILL

• <u>COMFORT</u> YOU.

16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another <u>Comforter</u>, that he may abide with you forever... John 14:16 KJV

• <u>COUNSEL</u> YOU.

13 But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. John 16:13

"Whether you turn to the right or to the left, your ears will hear a voice behind you, saying, 'This is the way; walk in it." Isaiah 30:21

• <u>CONVICT</u> YOU.

8 When (the Spirit) comes, he will <u>convict</u> the world of guilt in regard to sin and righteousness and judgment: John 16:8

4 On one occasion, while (Jesus) was eating with them, he gave them this command: "Do not leave Jerusalem, but wait for <u>the gift my Father promised</u>, which you have heard me speak about. 5 For John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be <u>baptized with the Holy Spirit</u>..."8 But you will receive <u>power</u> when the <u>Holy Spirit comes on you</u>; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Acts 1:4-5, 8

dunamis (doo'-nam-is); a force; a miraculous power, the explosive power of God.

HOLY SPIRIT GIVES YOU THE POWER

1) TO SHARE CHRIST <u>BOLDLY</u>.

4 My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a <u>demonstration of the</u> <u>Spirit's power</u>, 5 so that your faith might not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power. 1 Corinthians 2:4-5

2) WHEN YOU ARE <u>WEAK</u>.

26 In the same way, the Spirit <u>helps us in our weakness</u>. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but <u>the</u> <u>Spirit himself intercedes for us</u> with groans that words cannot express. Romans 8:26

"My grace is sufficient for you, for <u>my power is made perfect in weakness</u>." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me... For when I am weak, then I am strong. 2 Corinthians 12:9-10

3) TO HAVE <u>HOPE</u> IN A HOPELESS WORLD.

13 May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may <u>overflow with hope</u> by the <u>power of the Holy Spirit</u>. Romans 15:13

4) TO EXPERIENCE ALL THE <u>FULLNESS</u> OF GOD.

16 I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with <u>power through his Spirit</u> in your inner being, 17 so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, 18 may have <u>power</u>, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, 19 and to know this love that surpasses knowledge — that you may be filled to the measure of <u>all the fullness of God</u>. Ephesians 3:16-19

1 Now about spiritual gifts, brothers, I do not want you to be ignorant...4 There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit. 5 There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. 6 There are different kinds of working, but the same God works all of them in all men. 1 Corinthians 12:1, 4-6 NIV7 A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other. 1 Corinthians 12:7 NLT

SPIRITUAL GIFTS ARE NOT

- 1) NATURAL <u>TALENTS</u>.
- 2) GIVEN TO THE <u>ELITE</u> FEW.
- 3) SIGN OF SPIRITUAL MATURITY.
- 4) <u>FRUITS</u> OF THE SPIRIT.
- 5) SOMETHING TO <u>FEAR</u>.

WHAT ARE SOME OF THE SPIRITUAL GIFTS?

6 In his grace, God has given us different gifts for doing certain things well. So if God has given you the ability to <u>prophesy</u>, speak out with as much faith as God has given you. 7 If your gift is <u>serving others</u>, serve them well. If you are a <u>teacher</u>, teach well. 8 If your gift is to <u>encourage others</u>, be encouraging. If it is <u>giving</u>, give generously. If God has given you <u>leadership ability</u>, take the responsibility seriously. And if you have a gift for <u>showing kindness</u> to others, do it gladly. Romans 12:6-8 NLT

7 A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other. 8 To one person the Spirit gives the ability to give <u>wise advice</u>; to another the same Spirit gives a message of <u>special knowledge</u>. 9 The same Spirit gives great <u>faith</u> to another, and to someone else the one Spirit gives the <u>gift of healing</u>. 10 He gives one person the power to <u>perform miracles</u>, and another the ability to <u>prophesy</u>. He gives someone else the ability to <u>discern</u>

whether a message is from the Spirit of God or from another spirit. Still another person is given the ability to speak in <u>unknown languages</u>, while another is given the ability to <u>interpret</u> what is being said. 11 It is the one and only Spirit who distributes all these gifts. He alone decides which gift each person should have.

1 Corinthians 12:7-11 NLT

1) STUDY WHAT THE <u>BIBLE</u> SAYS ABOUT GIFTS.

- 4) TAKE A SPIRITUAL GIFT TEST.

5) DO WHAT THE HOLY SPIRIT <u>LEADS</u> YOU TO DO.

Then speak as though God himself were speaking through you. Do you have the gift of helping others? Do it with all the strength and energy that God supplies. GHOST—4 FILLED WITH THE SPIRIT

1 When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place. 2 Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting. 3 They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them. 4 All of them were <u>filled with the Holy Spirit</u> and began to speak in <u>other tongues</u> as the Spirit enabled them. Acts 2:1-4

WHAT DO WE KNOW ABOUT TONGUES?

1) WHEN SOMEONE SPEAKS IN TONGUES PUBLICLY, THERE SHOULD BE AN <u>INTERPRETATION</u>.

If anyone speaks in a tongue, two-or at the most three-should speak, one at a time, and <u>someone must interpret</u>. <i>28 If there is no interpreter, the speaker should keep quiet in the church and speak to himself and God. 1 Corinthians 14: 27-28

So if the whole church comes together and everyone speaks in tongues, and some who do not understand or some unbelievers come in, will they not say that you are out of your mind? 1 Corinthians 14:23

2) SPEAKING IN TONGUES STRENGTHENS THE <u>PERSON</u> SPEAKING NOT THE <u>CHURCH</u>.

4 A person who speaks in tongues is strengthened personally, but one who speaks a word of prophecy strengthens the entire church. 5 I wish you could all speak in tongues, but even more I wish you could all prophesy. For prophecy is greater than speaking in tongues, unless someone interprets what you are saying so that the whole church will be strengthened. 1 Corinthians 14:4-5

18 I thank God that I speak in tongues more than all of you. 19 But in the church I would rather speak five intelligible words to instruct others than ten thousand words in a tongue. 1 Corinthians 14:18-19

BE FILLED WITH THE SPIRIT

16 So I say, <u>live by the Spirit</u>, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature. 17 For the sinful nature desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the sinful nature. They are in conflict with each other, so that you do not do what you want. Galatians 5:16-17

15 So be careful how you live. Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise. 16 Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days. 17 Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do. 18 Don't be <u>drunk with wine</u>, because that will ruin your life. Instead, be <u>filled with the Holy Spirit</u>. Ephesians 5:15-18 NLT

25 Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit's leading in every part of our lives. Galatians 5:25 NLT
