Cessation - a fact or process of ending or being brought to an end.

Description / Prescription - something that happened or something that is happening.

The Book of Acts?

Is it for today? miracles, signs, tongues, etc.

1 Cor 13 -

Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away. **9** For we know in part, and we prophesy in part.

10 But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away. **11** When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things.

12 For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known.

Dispensation -

- 1. to dispense progressive revelation.
- 2. exemption from a rule or usual requirement.
- 3.a system of order, government, or organization of a nation, community, etc., especially as existing at a particular time
- 4.a general state or ordering of things; specifically: a system of revealed commands and promises regulating human affairs
- 5. a particular arrangement or provision especially of providence or nature.
- 6. The act of giving or portioning something out is called **dispensation**.
- 7. A **dispensation** of the gospel is a period of time in which the Lord has at least one authorized servant on the earth who bears the holy priesthood and the keys, and who has a divine commission to dispense the gospel to the inhabitants of the earth

Catholics -Dispensation is an act whereby in a particular case a lawful superior grants relaxation from an existing law
