The Devil Has "NO POWER" over "US" as "CHRISTIANS," "UNLESS" we Give it to him!!

The "Word of God" says that, "The devil has been stripped of his Power" and that "we have the Victory over the devil" it also says, "Resist the devil and he will flee"!! If we know this to be true and we do, then we need to be diligent in recognizing devil's strategies and cut him off before he gets the best of you and ruins your day or worse!! We already have the Victory, he is a defeated foe!! He roams about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. Take the authority over the devil and his dominion, let him know that "you" know "your" rights and authority in the "Name ABOVE All NAMES, Jesus Christ, OUR LORD and Savior"!! Rebuke the devil!! Command him to leave you alone in the Name of Jesus and thank Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ for the authority that He has given US over the devil and his dominion!!

resist

1.against; not yield to; fight against

2.to withstand the deleterious action of; be proof against: to resist corrosion

3.to oppose; refuse to accept or comply with

4.to refrain from, in spite of temptation

Question? How do you resist the devil? The Bible makes it very clear. Answer: Submit yourself therefore to God. Period!! James 4:7, says: Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. When you submit to God, you ignore the devil.

submit

1. to give over or yield to the power or authority of another.

2. to subject to some kind of influence.

3. to yield oneself to the power or authority of another.

How do we submit to God?? We read His "Uncompromised True Word". John 15:7, says: If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. "Diligently" read His (God's)Word and abide in it and you won't give the devil place in your life when he tries to attack!!

diligent

1. constant in effort to accomplish something; attentive and persistent in doing anything

2. done or pursued with persevering attention; painstaking.

Hebrews 2:14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death He might destroy him that "had"(had is past tense) the **power** of death, that is, the devil;

Colossians 2:15 *And* having spoiled principalities and **powers**, He made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

Colossians 1:13 Who hath delivered us from the **power** of darkness, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of His dear Son:

Revelation 1:18 I *am* He that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and **have** (present tense) the keys of hell and of death.

Acts 26:18 To open their eyes, *and* to turn *them* from darkness to light, and *from* the **power** of Satan "**unto God**", that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in Me.

Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive **power**, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Matthew 16:19 And I will give unto thee the **keys** of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

1 Corinthians 15:57 But thanks *be* to God, which give hus the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

1 John 5:4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the **victory** that **overcometh** the world, *even* our faith.

2 Corinthians 2:14 Now thanks *be* unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place.

2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

1 John 5:4 For whatsoever is born of God **overcometh** the world: and this is the victory that **overcometh** the world, *even* our faith.

1 John 5:5 Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

Revelation 3:5 He that **overcometh**, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

Revelation 3:21 To him that **overcometh** will I grant to sit with me in my throne, even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne.

Revelation 21:7 He that **overcometh** shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son.

Romans 8:37 Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him that loved us.

1 John 4:5 They are of the world: therefore speak they of the world, and the world **heareth** them.

1 John 4:6 We are of God: he that knoweth God **heareth** us; he that is not of God **heareth** not us. Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and the spirit of error.

John 10:27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me

We can clearly see that the Bible teaches the believer to put on the "Whole Armour of

God" that we may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

Ephesians 6:10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

Ephesians 6:11 Put on the **whole armour of God**, that ye may be able to **stand against the wiles of the devil.**

Ephesians 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Ephesians 6:13 Wherefore take unto you the **whole armour of God**, that ye may be able to **withstand in the evil day**, and **having done all, to stand**.

Ephesians 6:14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with **truth**, and having on the **breastplate of righteousness**;

Ephesians 6:15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

Ephesians 6:16 Above all, taking the **shield of faith**, wherewith **ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked**.

Ephesians 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

Romans 10:17 So then faith *cometh* by **hearing**, and **hearing** by the word of God.

Jesus is the "Word of God"
