- 1. Abram and Sarai are old and have no children.
- 2. God tells Abram he will have more descendants than there are stars in the Heavens.
- 3. Abraham means "Father of Many."
- 4. God did not change Abram's name.
- 5. Sarah means "pickle."
- 6. God changes Sarai's name to Sarah because she will be the Mother of Nations.
- 7. Sarah tells Abraham to have a son with her servant Hagar, and they name him Ishmael.
- 8. Three strangers pass by Abraham's camp, but he does not speak to them.
- 9. One of the strangers tells Abraham that Sarah will have a son.
- 10. Abraham finds out that God will have to destroy Sodom, where his nephew Lot lives, and pleads with God not to do so.
