WHAT MERITS CHURCH DISCIPLINE?

- 1. Doctrinal Heresy Jesus, Bible
- 2. Divisive Behavior undermining leadership
- 3. Unrepentant and defiant sinful lifestyle justifying unscriptural ongoing practice
 - * not committing a sin, or struggling with it
- 1. Immediate and primary goal is always reconciliation / restoration
- 2. conflict, confrontation in love
- 3. scriptural plan: Matt 5:23 -

if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother or sister has something against you, ²⁴ leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift.

Dealing With Sin in the Church

^{Matt 18:15} "If your brother or sister sins, go and point out their fault, just between the two of you. If they listen to you, you have won them over. ¹⁶ But if they will not listen, take one or two others along, so that 'every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses.' ¹⁷ If they still refuse to listen, tell it to the church; and if they refuse to listen even to the church, treat them as you would a pagan or a tax collector. ¹⁸ "Truly I tell you, whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven. ¹⁹ "Again, truly I tell you that if two of you on earth agree about anything they ask for, it will be done for them by my Father in heaven. ²⁰ For where two or three gather in my name, there am I with them."

Practical church discipline might include:

- 1. step down from leadership or any public position for a time of healing.
- 2. some denominations remove voting privileges of members?
- 3. final act if no remorse would include "Excommunication"
