## INWARD AND OUTWARD PURITY

1) OUTWARD PURITY: THE BEHAVIOR.

But among you there must not be even <u>a hint</u> of sexual immorality, or of <u>any kind of impurity</u>... Ephesians 5:3

2) INWARD PURITY: THE <u>HEART</u>.

How can a young man keep his way <u>pure</u>? By living according to <u>your word</u>. <sup>10</sup> I seek you with <u>all my heart</u>; do not let me stray from your commands. <sup>11</sup> I have hidden your word <u>in my heart</u> that I might not <u>sin against you</u>. Psalm 119:9-11

Prenup—don't want to lose my Chevy, golf clubs & my fish tank.

Covenant permanent relationship—no end date—till death do us part.

Berithe—cutting... Cut hands!

To be wife, have and hold—From this day forward—long as both live.

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Ruth Graham... ever consider divorcing Billy I'm not happy. I don't trust him. I don't love her.

Get divorced because you ran out of love is like selling your car because it ran out of gas. Will run out of love—God never runs out of love!

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## **SOWING AND REAPING IN MARRIAGE**

7 Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man <u>reaps what he sows</u>. 8 The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature will reap destruction; the one who sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life. 9 Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we <u>do not give up</u>.

Not going to feed my baby—don't feel like it.
