- 1. Emotionally attached to opinions and outburst over how others treat them.
- 2. Pride in How Much Bible You Know
- 3. Truth without Grace
- 4. Grace Without Truth
- 5. Harshness Toward Outsiders While Cutting Insiders Slack
- 6. Telling people you're mature, and how much you do

Mature Christians are **RESPONSIBLE** for themselves and others by giving, serving, teaching, and leading.

Mature Christians stop pointing out everyone else's sins, and start confessing their own

Mature Christians Watch Their Words, and know when NOT to speak

Mature Christians are Less Dependent on Themselves, (their accomplishments) and Increasingly dependent on Christ

Mature Christians are spiritually hungry and seek opportunities to learn / grow

Your life is guided by a core set of principles and values

You are slow to hold on to grudges and quick to forgive

You care deeply for the poor, the marginalized, and the downtrodden

You maintain your childlike sense of wonder, yet live with a sense of responsibility for others

You defer pleasure

You are dependable

You are at peace with what cannot be changed

have a stronger desire to separate myself from the things of this world have a growing love for other people
