# Sola Scriptura =

#### Authority of the Scriptures Alone

As Protestants, we are justified <u>by faith alone</u>. This separates us from the belief of the 7 Catholic sacraments that are required for salvation, or becoming a Mormon missionary, or serving as a Jehovah's witness going door to door. Religious works are required by cults to hope for the possibility of salvation, with no guarantee! These works help further the secure establishment of a religious organization, but are counterfeit efforts to earn Gods love. The Holy Spirit does not require the help of religion for Him to build His church.

All cults seem Christian in some ways, but add to or control the authority of scripture such as the apocrypha for Catholics. They also elevate the Popes ability to speak "ex-cathedra" which gives him God like authority and reserve extra authority through the traditions of the church. These are all equal to the Bible itself. Jehovah's witness' only use their own "new world" authorized translation and limit all interpretation to the watch tower society in New York. Mormons use several books they consider authoritative such as "Doctrines and Covenants", "the pearl of great price", and the book of Mormon. All these examples violate "Sola Scriptura"

- Afterlife: all spirits go to the the spirit world. The good spends time in the spirit paradise while the evil go to prison
- Hell: wicked enter "spirit prison" then considered "Outer Darkness" for eternity.
- Symbol: Cross is not used. Trumpet is seen atop of Mormon temples
- Deny sin of human
- · Worship in chapel or temple
- · Salvation: works are more important

# SIGNS of a "Christian" Cult




They add to the Word of God. It's never the Bible alone as its authority. Publications such as The Book of Mormon, Pearl of Great Price, Science & Health, and AWAKE and Watchtower magazines are given equal and greater importance over Scripture.



They subtract from the Diety of Jesus. They will say he's a prophet, a teacher, the devil's brother, Michael the archangel, the son of God - but never God in the flesh. They may also subtract from the personhood of the Holy Spirit by reducing Him to an impersonal force used by God.



They multiply works to gain salvation. It is never grace alone. You must join them, be baptized, you must go door to door, you must strictly obey commandments, no one is saved by grace through faith in Jesus Christ alone.



They will divide your loyalties. They are an antichrist group. You are deceived into placing your primary loyalty toward the cult and its leaders instead of the Lord Jesus Christ. Also, you are discouraged from associating with non-members, and forbidden to have anything to do with ex-members. Where true Christians are encouraged to maintain contact and closeness with unbelieving family members, these groups do not.
