Charles Stanley - making wise decisions –

- 1. God wants to reveal himself every single time you ask
- 2. He may not answer like you want
- 3. Settle the most important decision first (accepting Christ)
- 4. What is your **process for making decisions**? A plan
 - a. Proven over the past 50 years from C Stanley
 - b. Psalm 25:12 fear God and he will instruct you
 - c. Who do you personally ask? Usually your "go to"
 - d. Clear your heart of any known sin, ask Him to show you
 - e. What keeps you from hearing truth?
 - f. Bring your desires to a neutral position, I can take it or leave it.
 - g. Psalm 37:4 He knows what will make you miserable or fulfilled
 - h. Exercise patience (don't ask seek knock for an immediate answer)
 - i. Refuse to run ahead of Him...be still and know
 - j. He knows when your <u>ready</u> for the answer, maybe the answer is yes but not now. (He may be waiting on you)
 - k. Be alert to <u>pressure</u> to act unwisely (external, friends, circumstances) internal = your heart, your flesh
- 5. A Fresh rhema word comes always at 11:59! God will shut you down and reveal things when you get nervous about the deadline.
- Continue in prayer, <u>trust</u> and thanksgiving even without a specific answer.
- 7. Be exited about what He is about to **<u>teach you</u>** through this process.
- 8. Rest in **<u>His promise</u>** to act on your behalf. Embrace assurance.
- 9. Wait for His Peace (Col. 3:15) Peace will rule!
