## <u>Protestants biggest problem with Catholics –</u>

## "Irreconcilable differences"

Martin Luther called this sola scriptura and sola fide

(faith alone and scripture alone)

- 1. Salvation by works (sacraments) and maybe you'll get to heaven.
- 2. Apocrypha 14 added books in the Catholic Bible

3. The Popes infallibility and authority over scripture. The Magisterium includes church hierarchy of bishops and cardinals.

- 4. The requirement of church membership and traditions (catechism) for salvation
- 5. Transubstantiation eucharist literal body and blood (not communion)
- 6. Confession to a priest instead of going to Jesus directly
- 7. Praying to saints and Mary (or praying "through" them)
- 8. Penance religious penalty to pay for sins
- 9. Indulgences paying money to get out of purgatory
- 10. Purgatory a holding place between heaven and hell

11. Priesthood of all believers - Protestants see the church as having a horizontal structure with all believers being equal in position with Christ.

12. Differentiate Justification and Sanctification – immediately righteous with God at the point of salvation and a progressive holy life as we become sanctified.Catholics believe that "justification" of salvation is a daily progress with no guarantee of ever accomplishing it fully without a life of good works.

These are such "BIG DEALS" that many reformers, aprox 300, were killed, executed and martyred for taking a stand and committing "heresy" by speaking out publicly against the catholic church around 1500 ad.
