Christian Native American core Values:

1. I will at all times acknowledge and seek the creator God for my life's journey here on earth.

2. We will use caution in the idea that "Native Americans believe" thus and so, because of the many varied tribes and beliefs, understanding that some things may be similar but not always the same.

3. I will be a student, learner or follower of the "Jesus way", also known as a disciple. I will share my personal experience but will strive to learn more than I instruct others.

4. I will be a good steward or caretaker of all He has entrusted to me and my family. I understand that any so called "property" is on temporary loan from God.

5. I will not pursue greed in taking more than I need or placing myself above the needs of others. I will contribute to the group.

6. I will do everything in my power to live at peace with and respect other cultures, knowing that they may not understand my personal traditions. Community comes before the independent pride of having things my way.

7. I will follow only The Creators plan from His word known as the Bible, and renounce any superstitions that contradict his boundaries.

8. As a Jesus follower, I will not consult other gods, animals, practices, beliefs or nameless spirits who have no spiritual power over me.

Another way of putting it:

- 1. arrive early and stay late to set up, and clean up.
- 2. make it a priority to commit to coming each week.
- 3. contribute by giving an offering or sacrifice time to cook.
- 4. read a book, watch a video and share what you learn.
- 5. lay down your pride about your past beliefs and consult the Bible.
- 6. Accept Christ as savior and trust in Him alone.
