"Phobia" movement - (Homophobia, Transophobia, Islamophobia, etc)

Modern Liberal thinkers use this as a defense by attacking any so called non tolerance of their position. A group of phobias may be rolled together to create a stronger position.

PHOBIA - an extreme or irrational fear of, or aversion to something.

Consider the possible position of *fear from conservative Christian values* such as the Bible, Christ, sin, and truth.

<u>Bibliophobia</u> – afraid to take the Bible at face value or surrender to it's authority over your opinions, traditions, ideas, or religion. Excuse any chapter and verse statements or essential doctrines of holy living.

<u>Christophobia</u> – afraid to surrender to the Lordship of Jesus Christ. Fear of giving control to God through the person of Jesus. Concerned that He may contradict my personal politics or remanufactured image of love as I define it.

<u>Sinophobia</u> – the fear of having to repent from, change or admit that my behavior might not be pleasing to God. If I can define sin on my terms, I do not even have to adjust my way thinking about violating Gods boundaries. Situational ethics and personal morality is defined by my choices alone and never applies to others. As long as I don't hurt anyone, sin is not an issue.

<u>Truthophobia</u> – fear of any absolute truth set by a higher standard outside of my own personal moral compass. I define truth at the moment and it is subject to change as it suits my needs.

Heb 4:12 - For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

John 14:6 - Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

Rom 3:23 – all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. Rom 6:23 – The wages of sin is death.

Isa 64:6 - All of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous acts are like filthy rags; we all shrivel up like a leaf, and like the wind our sins sweep us away.

John 8:32 - Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."

John 16:13 - But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. John 18:37 - "You are saying that I am a king," Jesus told him. "I was born into this world to tell about the truth. And everyone who belongs to the truth knows my voice."
