#### **Root of Pride:**

God detests pride. He even hates a proud look (Prov. 6:16-17).

God's loathing of pride is unalterable, for "Every one that is proud in heart is an abomination to the LORD" (Prov. 16:5).

7 attributes – John Piper

- 1. fault finding
- 2. harsh spirit
- 3. superficial thinking, talking, & behavior
- 4. defensiveness
- 5. presumptions
- 6. desperation for attention
- 7. neglecting / ignoring / dismissing others

Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts! And see if there be any grievous way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting! (Psalm 139:23–24)

Undetected pride – Johnathon Edwards

- 1. secret opinions of condescension toward everyone
- 2. offended easily and often

Rom 12:3 - Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment,

**Disguises** for people with pride might include: (rubber nose and glasses)

- 1. unhealthy isolation, withdrawal and depression
- 2. manipulation by passive aggressive defiance and suspicion
- 3. perfectionism
- 4. Impatience

Psychological "NEED" for pride? Take pride in yourself... self respect = self worth We feel secure in our own comfort zone / turf / culture / surroundings...

Thus we are insecure, nervous and embarrassed when we are out of our comfort zone. (when we drive, we use my car, we go to my restaurant, shop at my store, listen to my music, on and on)

#### My Identity is in Christ, (should be, Must be, shall be!)

BUT ... Pride finds Identity (and self worth) in...

- 1. accomplishments, popularity, approval
- 2. Title and position
- 3. Pedigree (heritage, family name, lineage, culture)
- 4. competitions and victories,
- 5. stature, attractiveness
- 6. vocabulary, education
- 7. financial net worth, social status
- 8. possessions property, houses, cars, clothes
