

## **The CALL of God to YOU !**

To...Salvation, service, holiness, ministry, obedience...

**Gen 3:8** - But the LORD God called to the man, "Where are you?"

**Gen 12:1** - The LORD had said to Abram, "Go from your country, your people and your father's household to the land I will show you.

**Gen 6:8** - But the LORD was pleased with Noah... He lived in fellowship with God,<sup>11</sup> but everyone else was evil in God's sight, and violence had spread everywhere.<sup>13</sup> God said to Noah, "I have decided to put an end to all people. I will destroy them completely, because the world is full of their violent deeds. <sup>14</sup> Build a boat for yourself out of good timber

**Exod 3:4** - When the LORD saw that Moses was coming closer, he called to him from the middle of the bush and said, "Moses! Moses!"

**1 Sam 3:4** - Then the LORD called Samuel. Samuel answered, "Here I am."

The LORD called Samuel a third time, and Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me." Then Eli realized that the LORD was calling the boy.

**1 Sam 16:12** - Then the LORD said, "Rise and anoint him; this is the one."<sup>13</sup> So Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the presence of his brothers, and from that day on the Spirit of the LORD came powerfully upon David.

**Isaiah 6:8** - Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" And I said, "Here am I. Send me!"

**Matt 1:20** - But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit.

**Matt 4:18** - "Come, follow me," Jesus said, "and I will send you out to fish for people."<sup>20</sup> At once they left their nets and followed him. <sup>21</sup> Going on from there, he saw two other brothers, James son of Zebedee and his brother John. They were in a boat with their father Zebedee, preparing their nets. Jesus called them, <sup>22</sup> and immediately they left the boat and their father and followed him.

**Matt 10:1** - Jesus called his twelve disciples to him and gave them authority to drive out impure spirits and to heal every disease and sickness.

**Matt 22:14** - For many are called, but few are chosen.

**1 Peter 2:9** - But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a peculiar people, that ye should show forth the praises of Him who hath called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

**Heb 9:15** - For this reason He is the mediator of a new covenant, so that, since a death has taken place for the redemption of the transgressions that were committed under the first covenant, those who have been called may receive the promise of the eternal inheritance.

**Jude 1:1** - Jude, a bond-servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, To those who are the called, beloved in God the Father, and kept for Jesus Christ:

[John 5:25](#) "Truly, truly, I say to you, an hour is coming and now is, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live.

[John 10:3](#) "To him the doorkeeper opens, and the sheep hear his voice, and he calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.

[Romans 1:6](#) among whom you also are the called of Jesus Christ;

[Romans 8:30](#) and these whom He predestined, He also called; and these whom He called, He also justified; and these whom He justified, He also glorified.

[Romans 11:29](#) for the gifts and the calling of God are irrevocable.

[1 Corinthians 7:18-22](#) Was any man called when he was already circumcised? He is not to become uncircumcised. Has anyone been called in uncircumcision? He is not to be circumcised. Circumcision is nothing, and uncircumcision is nothing, but what matters is the keeping of the commandments of God. Each man must remain in that condition in which he was called.

[Galatians 1:6](#) I am amazed that you are so quickly deserting Him who called you by the grace of Christ, for a different gospel;

[Ephesians 4:1](#) Therefore I, the prisoner of the Lord, implore you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling with which you have been called,

[Philippians 3:14](#) I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

[2 Thessalonians 1:11](#) To this end also we pray for you always, that our God will count you worthy of your calling, and fulfill every desire for goodness and the work of faith with power,

[2 Thessalonians 2:14](#) It was for this He called you through our gospel, that you may gain the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

[1 Timothy 6:12](#) Fight the good fight of faith; take hold of the eternal life to which you were called, and you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

[Hebrews 3:1](#) Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of a heavenly calling, consider Jesus, the Apostle and High Priest of our confession;

[1 Peter 5:10](#) After you have suffered for a little while, the God of all grace, who called you to His eternal glory in Christ, will Himself perfect, confirm, strengthen and establish you.

[2 Peter 1:3](#) seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence.

[2 Peter 1:10](#) Therefore, brethren, be all the more diligent to make certain about His calling and choosing you; for as long as you practice these things, you will never stumble;

[Revelation 17:14](#) "These will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because He is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those who are with Him are the called and chosen and faithful."
