## FISH! THE GREAT FISH!



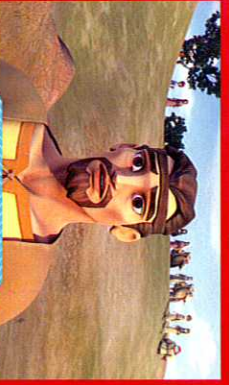
When Jonah was drowning, God sent a great fish to swallow him and bring him to dry land.

## JONAH

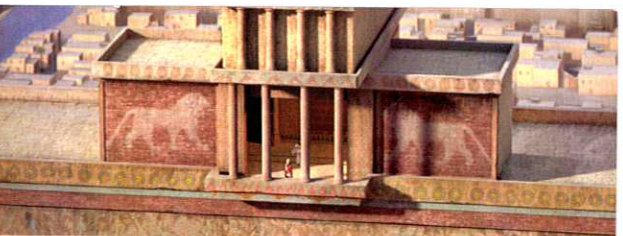
