## LIONS' DEN

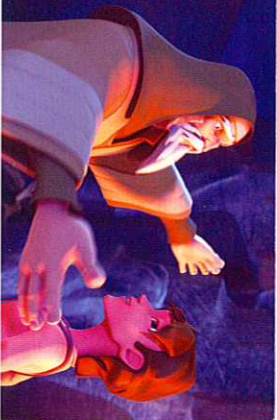

## ABRAHAM

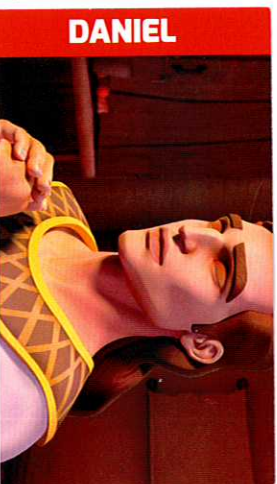

## DANIEL

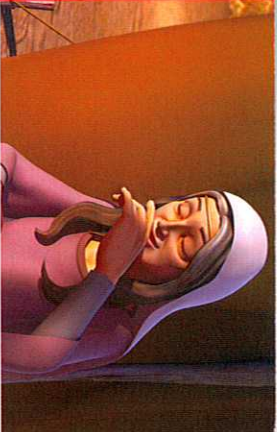
