Penance vs propitiation -

1 John 2:2 (KJV) reads: "And he is the **propitiation** for our **sins**: and not for ours only, but also for the **sins** of the whole world."

You might offer your mom a plate of chocolate chip cookies in **propitiation** for killing all her houseplants while she was away. **Propitiation** comes from a form of the Latin verb "propitiare," which **means** "to appease."
