Isa 11:6 - The wolf will live with the lamb, the leopard will lie down with the goat, the calf and the lion and the yearling together; and a little child will lead them.

<sup>7</sup>The cow will feed with the bear, their young will lie down together,

and the lion will eat straw like the ox.<sup>8</sup>The infant will play near the cobra's den,

and the young child will put its hand into the viper's nest.<sup>9</sup>They will neither harm nor destroy on all my holy mountain, (also in isa 65:25 - )

1 Peter 5:8 - The devil goes around LIKE a roaring lion... so we are CHARGED to...

you who are younger, **submit** yourselves to your elders. All of you, clothe yourselves with humility toward one another, **Humble** yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time. <sup>7</sup> **Cast all your anxiety** on him because he cares for you.

<sup>8</sup> **Be alert and of sober mind.** Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour. <sup>9</sup> **Resist him, standing firm in the faith,**

A prophet was killed by a lion – 1 kings 13:24 As he went on his way, a lion met him on the road and killed him, and his body was left lying on the road, with both the donkey and the lion standing beside it. – 26 - “It is the man of God who defied the word of the Lord. The Lord has given him over to the lion, which has mauled him and killed him, as the word of the Lord had warned him.”

Psalms 17:8-12 - The wicked are out to get you! Ps 35:17 - How long, Lord, will you look on? Rescue me from their ravages, my precious life from these lions.

Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings

<sup>9</sup> from the wicked who are out to destroy me, from my mortal enemies who surround me.

<sup>10</sup> They close up their callous hearts, and their mouths speak with arrogance.

<sup>11</sup> They have tracked me down, they now surround me, with eyes alert, to throw me to the ground. <sup>12</sup> They are like a lion hungry for prey, like a fierce lion crouching in cover.

Daniel tamed the Lions Dan 6:7, but his accusers were eaten by the same lions. 6:24

24 At the king's command, the men who had falsely accused Daniel were brought in and thrown into the lions' den, along with their wives and children. And before they reached the floor of the den, the lions overpowered them and crushed all their bones.

Samson Judges 14:5, but his riddles about the lion was his downfall

12 "Let me tell you a riddle," Samson said to them. "If you can give me the answer within the seven days of the feast, I will give you thirty linen garments and thirty sets of clothes...

16 Then Samson's wife threw herself on him, sobbing, "You hate me! You don't really love me. You've given my people a riddle, but you haven't told me the answer."

17 She cried the whole seven days of the feast. So on the seventh day he finally told her, because she continued to press him. She in turn explained the riddle to her people.

He went down to Ashkelon, struck down thirty of their men, stripped them of everything and gave their clothes to those who had explained the riddle. Burning with anger, he returned to his father's home. 20 And Samson's wife was given to one of his companions who had attended him at the feast.

The LION and the Lamb -- Rev 5 / **THE LION IS THE LAMB** ! You have to know whos who!

4 I wept and wept because no one was found who was worthy to open the scroll or look inside. 5 Then one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep! See, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has triumphed. He is able to open the scroll and its seven seals."

12 In a loud voice they were saying: "Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain,

to receive power and wealth and wisdom and strength and honor and glory and praise!"

13 Then I heard every creature in heaven and on earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all that is in them, saying: "To him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb

be praise and honor and glory and power, for ever and ever!"
