10 ways to know that church is all about YOU! (indicators of spiritual immaturity)

- 1. You attend when it's convenient (Inconvenient includes)
 - a. don't feel good
 - b. woke up late
 - c. busy with something else (lake, in-laws, etc)
 - 2. You serve / volunteer once a year or not at all
 - 3. You give an offering of whatever cash happens to be in your pocket (maybe)
 - 4. You sing (not to loud) only when that 1 favorite song is happening.
 - 5. I don't attend a small group of any kind
 - 6. You expect all your spiritual food (Bible study) for the week in 30 minutes or less, and it better be entertaining!
 - 7. I do not ask how the Pastor, staff, or leaders could use any help.
 - 8. I am "put out" if parking or seating or restrooms are a bother in any way.
 - 9. I am offended if people do not know me by name and ask about me and my family's needs.
 - 10. If you spend any possible "quiet time" on your phone instead of approaching someone else.

For those at the next level (who give, serve, have devotions, even lead)

- 1. You get offended when another leader tells you NO.
- 2. You don't like how others serve, or their commitment is lacking.
- 3. Policy is not the way you want it to be, or changes without your permission.
- 4. You assume things should be a certain way, and don't like asking for clarification. You're not very teachable.
- 5. Money from another budget is not in your control.
- 6. Procedures to get things done is frustrating and makes you want to quit.
- 7. Your supervisor's personality or style is frustrating and makes you want to quit.
- 8. You feel responsible for someone else's sins.
- 9. You pout when your feelings are hurt.
- 10. You threaten to quit.
- Frustration is an indicator of a lack of understanding, lack of cooperation and restricts your control over others.
