As believers... As American citizens -

Rights are legal, social, or ethical principles of freedom or **<u>entitlement</u>**; that is, **rights** are the fundamental normative rules about what is allowed of people or owed to people according to some legal system, social convention, or ethical theory.

Bill of rights – the first 10 amendments to the constitution.

30 HUMAN rights under - United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights

"RIGHTS" of the Nation of Israel -

preserve, protect, defend, honor the sacred (law, property / land, people)

^{Exod 21:23} But if there is serious injury, you are to take life for life, ²⁴ eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot, ²⁵ burn for burn, wound for wound, bruise for bruise.

Self preservation = I'm gonna get whats mine!

<u>Gen 4</u>: Abel also brought of the firstborn of his flock and of their fat portions. And the Lord had regard for Abel and his offering, but for Cain and his offering he had no regard. So Cain was very angry, and his face fell.

Parents – when I was a child (I was a consumer)

Boss at work (not motivated by what you want, but what your people need)

Boundaries are the line of when to say yes and when to say NO. what this policy does for me or what it does for YOU.

BURDEN = LOAD - capacity, capable "the burden of a sea going vessel, <u>a beast of burden."</u>

Phil 2:4 - not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

Phil 2:8 - Think of yourselves the way Christ Jesus thought of himself. He had equal status with God but didn't think so much of himself that he had to cling to the advantages of that status no matter what. Not at all. When the time came, he set aside the privileges of deity and took on the status of a slave, became *human*! Having become human,. He didn't claim special privileges. Instead, he lived a selfless, obedient life and then died a selfless, obedient death—and the worst kind of death at that—a crucifixion.
