- 2. Rights are about what you can do, what is allowed.
- 3. Responsibility is about what you should do.
- 4. They need more respectability and depth. (because)
- 5. Rights don't give you much direction
- 6. Rights are shallow and without meaning
- 7. Life is a difficult journey, you need dignity and contribution to feel a sense of purpose.
- 8. Society and social circles are important to this generation. Those circles can not function apart from our responsibility for one another.
- 9. Those who get responsibility are those who will lead.

- 1. Leaders consistently get there early and stay late.
- 2. Leaders provide and take care of followers
- 3. Leaders listen, followers verbally advertise everything.
- 4. Followers are looking to be fed, defining their rights.
- 5. Immature "takers" have high expectations of what they need.
- 6. Believers receive benefits of the gospel.
- 7. Disciples go, share, serve, teach, and reach others.
