<u>Prophet</u> – One who speaks on Gods behalf, something that only God would know about secret or future events.

<u>Prophecy</u> – a proclamation, a fore telling of things to come. A Divine promise revealing good or bad predictions. Often meant as a warning.

2,500 prophecies in the Bible. 2,000 have been fulfilled. 500 about our future, not yet fulfilled. The odds for all these prophecies having been fulfilled by chance without error is less than one in 10²⁰⁰⁰ (that is 1 with 2,000 zeros written after it)! More than 100 billion, or 100 trillion!

Past prophecy in the Bible –

- 1. Christ birth, death, resurrection

 Daniel prophesied that the messiah / Christ would be born and be killed. Micah prophesied that he would be born in Bethlehem. Isaiah prophesied about his whipping, Zechariah said he would be sold for the price of a slave, several prophets said he would be crucified 400 years before this practice was invented. The spear in his side, the humiliating torture, and his friends abandoning him were all predicted.
- 2. Nation of Israel Moses and Jerimiah prophesied about the fall of the nation and its rebirth 3,500 years in advance.
- 3. The future of Israel 500 prophecies will come to pass.

 Rapture, mark of beast, judgement, tribulation, anti-Christ, Temple

Given that the Bible proves so reliable a document, there is every reason to expect that the remaining 500 prophecies, those slated for the "time of the end," also will be fulfilled to the last letter. Who can afford to ignore these coming events?

How does this affect us today?

1. Urgency... (get ready, get others ready)

No man knows the day, work while we have day, for the night is coming, we will be caught unaware, one taken, one left,

2. Conviction... (personally convinced, not able to be swayed by arguments)

Be ready always to give an account, see the signs, warn the idle!

3. Prioritize our life, relationships, possessions, set your house in order!
