DEFINED:

1. TRUST – ARE THEY HONEST, TRANSPARENT, OR PRETEND AND AVOID
2. LOYALTY – WOULD THEY SAY SOMETHING DIFFERENT BEHIND YOUR BACK? DO THEY MAKE THIS RELATIONSHIP A HIGH PRIORITY?
3. FAITH - do they value their commitment to their faith?
4. FAMILY – IMMEDIATE, EXTENDED, SINGLE, MARRIED, KIDS, CAN FRIENDS GET IN THE WAY OR ARE THEY INCLUDED AS FAMILY?
5. COMMUNICATION – DO WE TALK, TEXT, VISIT, SHARE IMPORTANT INFO, ASK OPINIONS? CAN WE DISAGREE AND RESPECT EACH OTHER?
6. Finances – HOW WE SPEND MONEY, HOW WE WANT TO OR SHOULD SPEND IT.
7. POLITICS – LIBERAL OR CONSERVATIVE? WHY? PERSONALITIES OR PLATFORMS?
8. WORK ETHIC – JOB OR CAREER? AMBITION OR STABILITY? COMPANY MAN OR MAVERIC?
9. PERSONAL GOALS – SELF RESPECT, FAILURES, WEEKNESSES, HOPES AND DREAMS.
10. HUMOR & HOBBIES – DO THEY “GET ME”? CAN I SHARE THE LITTLE THINGS?
