“KINGDOM AMBITION”

1. We are Christian fundamentalists (NOT stereotypical such as Westboro Baptist)
 - a. take the Bible literally, believing it is inspired
 - b. view a distinct separation of believers and unbelievers
 - c. Salvation is exclusive and limited to one way
2. Radical Islamic fundamentalists are NOT comparable: (however)
 - a. believe the Koran is inspired, take it literally
 - b. separate believers and infidels
 - c. Salvation is exclusive and limited to one way

Differences – we are called to love, pray for, forgive and serve the world

Their fundamentalists seek to dominate, assimilate, or annihilate

Terrorism stems from a belief of hate for opposite culture and absolutism which rejects separation of church and state. The overthrow of a godless secular government and conquest of the land is the intent.

History shows Christians who have played into that belief with “Manifest Destiny” and Native Americans.

The mild application or modern version is called imminent domain.

“Mein Kampf” – was Hitlers ideology to destroy the weak in order to provide space and purity for the strong.

Militant Christians like David Koresch might enjoy the violent Video Game entitled “Left behind” where the Militia faithful killed unbelievers.
