Acts 2:42-47...fellowship, discipleship, worship, evangelism

All corporately, collectively.

1. Withdraw from people, because people are difficult.

Hurt people, hurt people. Walking wounded. Perpetual victims.

- 2. we have been rejected so we reject others. Often pre-emptive, and protective Child with abandonment, or attachment. Adult divorce, sibling rivalry.
- 3. share our life, our story, our resources for a common good / purpose.

Overflowing with life, love, joy, compassion, healing, hope.

How can we be pretty, even when life is ugly?

how to deal with people who can be pretty ugly, and how to avoid being pretty on the outside only to end up ugly on the inside.

We have curb appeal but our plumbing, elect, and foundation are substandard.

<u>The Golden Rule</u> (Matt 7:12) breeds, fosters, enables life and community.

These Acts ch 2 people were persecuted. They had reason to live in fear.

They were accused of being heretics, cultists, probably insecure about speaking out. They were redeemed! They were healed, they were loved supernaturally.

They had something to give!

2 Cor 4:16 -- Outward vs Inward / 2 Cor 5:7 - Not by sight but by faith.

Outward signs?

Inward character / integrity? Belief, convictions
