SAMSON—3 SMALL STEPS TOWARD BIG DESTRUCTION

Strong man—weak will: I want it. I deserve it. I can handle it. Satan loves to make strong men weak. God makes weak men strong.

Emotion driven not spirit led. Anger/Pride: Main Character! Need drive you to God—meet your deepest need. Thirsty: Cried out to God!

19 Then God opened up the hollow place in Lehi, and water came out of it. When Samson drank, his <u>strength returned</u> and he <u>revived</u>. So the spring was called En Hakkore, and it is still there in Lehi. 20 Samson led Israel for <u>twenty years</u> in the days of the Philistines. Judg 15:19-20

Right track! 20 years of peace, prosperity, relative freedom. Looks like he put his problems behind him. Ignored, Covered.

Eyes gouged out, laughing stock! How did he go from _____ to ____?

• SAMSON DIDN'T RUIN HIS LIFE ALL AT ONCE. HE RUINED IT ONE <u>STEP</u> AT A TIME.

<u>One day</u> Samson went to Gaza, where he saw a <u>prostitute</u>. He went in to spend the night with her. 2 The people of Gaza were told, "Samson is here!" So they surrounded the place and lay in wait for him all night at the city gate. They made no move during the night, saying, "At dawn we'll kill him." Judges 16:1-2

One day-David and Bathsheba

Gaza—Philistine headquarters, Public enemy #1. Gaza is 25 miles from Samson's home town Zorah.

Stupid enough to risk so much for a quick hit? Countless men do it every day.

25 miles: 56,250 steps Sexual addiction, Bankruptcy, Affair

SAMSON'S SMALL STEPS TOWARD HIS BIG DESTRUCTION

1) SAMSON <u>TAUNTED</u> HIS ENEMY.

3 But Samson lay there only until the middle of the night. Then he got up and took hold of the doors of the city gate, together with the two posts, and tore them loose, bar and all. He lifted them to his shoulders and carried them to the top of the hill that faces Hebron. Judg 16:3

Main entrance * 700 lb. doors * Destroying symbol of security

As men, we often underestimate our enemy! Lion—seeking someone to devour. 3 legged cat!

Girlfriend stay, Go to the bar, Look at site, Smoke weed.

So, if you think you are standing firm, be careful that you don't fall! 1 Cor. 10:12

2) SAMSON <u>RATIONALIZED</u> THE SAME OLD SIN.

4 Some time later, he fell in love with a woman in the Valley of Sorek whose name was <u>Delilah</u>. Judges 16:4 (Del—love someone 2nite.)

No big deal, Just looking, Not going to hurt anyone, No one else's buz If she would, I wouldn't, Work hard, I deserve it.

5 The rulers of the Philistines went to (Delilah) and said, "See if you can lure him into showing you the secret of his great strength and how we can overpower him so we may tie him up and subdue him... Judges 16:5

6-14, 7 fresh straps * New ropes * 7 braids hair fabric & tighten w/pin.

15 Then she said to him, "How can you say, 'I love you,' when you won't confide in me? This is the third time you have made a fool of me and haven't told me the secret of your great strength." 16 With such <u>nagging</u> she prodded him day after day until he was <u>tired to death</u>. Judges 16:15-16

Strong enough kill 1000 men, lion, 700 lb door—Not to lead woman. 17 So he told her everything. "No razor has ever been used on my head," he said, "because I have been a Nazirite set apart to God since <u>birth</u>. If my head were shaved, my strength would leave me, and I would become as weak as any other man." Judges 16:17

19 Having put him to sleep on her lap, she called a man to shave off the seven braids of his hair, and so began to subdue him. <u>And his</u> <u>strength left him</u>. Judges 16:19

3) SAMSON ASSUMED HIS DISOBEDIENCE WOULD NEVER <u>COST</u> HIM.

20 Then she called, "Samson, the Philistines are upon you!" He awoke from his sleep and thought, "<u>I'll go out as before and shake myself</u> <u>free</u>." But <u>he did not know that the Lord had left him</u>. 21 Then the Philistines seized him, gouged out his eyes and took him down to Gaza. Binding him with bronze shackles, they set him to grinding in the prison.

Samson didn't ruin his life all at once. He ruined it one step at a time.

• WHERE ARE YOU STEPPING AWAY FROM GOD?

Undisciplined life, anger, pride, lust, greed, gambling, addiction, passivity, workaholism, lying, Hair is long—heart drifted!

You are only as strong as you are honest!

Turn around.

22 But the hair on his head began to grow again after it had been shaved.

Just because he's down, doesn't mean he's out. Courage to turn around!
