## Walk in Resurrection power! (overcomer, more than a conqueror, Joint Heir)

Sure...but why not? What is it?

It is to be alive after once having been dead, to restore a dead person to life.

Worldly application would be a spiritual zombie!

A *zombie* is a mythological undead, or to animate a corpse. (Rom 8:vs 6, vs 13 if we live according to the flesh, we will die)

- 1. our flesh sins (passions & appetites, ie-money, food, sex, emotional high)
- 2. flesh is self serving (taker not a giver)
- 3. flesh is robotic, stupid, not enlightened.

Rom 8: <sup>5</sup> Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires. <sup>6</sup> The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace. <sup>7</sup> The mind governed by the flesh is hostile to God; it does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so. <sup>8</sup> Those who are in the realm of the flesh cannot please God.

<sup>9</sup> You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ. <sup>10</sup> But if Christ is in you, then even though your body is subject to death because of sin, the Spirit gives life because of righteousness. <sup>11</sup> And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you.

## Here's why were not walking in Rez power...

## **1. we have not repented** (repent or perish)

Were just sorry we got caught! But we really like our sin. We've made it at home, we've adopted it, we dress it up, we brag about it.

Own it. Take full responsibility. Ask for mercy. Turn away from it.

## 2. we will not forgive others

Expect people to sin against you. Forgive in advance, not by how you feel.

We forget what a debt we have, and He has paid for us.

You do not have to sanction their behavior, nor do you have to be poisoned by it!

- Matthew 28:5-6: "The angel said to the women, 'Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay.""
- John 11:25: "Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live."
- Revelation 1:17b-18a: "Don't be afraid! I
  am the First and Last. I am the living one.
  I died, but look-I am alive forever and
  ever!"
- Mark 16:1-4: "When the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices so that they might go to anoint Jesus' body. Very early on the first day of the week, just after sunrise, they were on their way to the tomb and they asked each other, 'Who will roll the stone away from the entrance of the tomb?' But when they looked up, they saw that the stone, which was very large, had been rolled away."
- John 14:6: "Jesus answered, 'I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

- John 11:25-26: "Jesus said to her, 'I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me will live, even though they die; and whoever lives by believing in me will never die. Do you believe this?""
- 1 Peter 1:3: "Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead."
- 1 Corinthians 15:21: "For since death came through a man, the resurrection of the dead comes also through a man."
- Philippians 3:10: "I want to know Christ yes, to know the power of his resurrection and participation in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death."
- Acts 4:33: "With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all."
- Luke 24:6-7: "He is not here; he has risen!"

- 2 Corinthians 5:17: "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"
- Mark 15:46-47: So Joseph bought some linen cloth, took down the body, wrapped it in the linen, and placed it in a tomb cut out of rock. Then he rolled a stone against the entrance of the tomb. 47Mary Magdalene and Mary the mother of Joseph saw where he was laid.
- Luke 24:2-3: "They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus."
- Colossians 1:13-14: "For he has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves, in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins."
- Acts 4:33: "With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all."

- 1 Corinthians 6:14: "And God raised the Lord and will also raise us up by his power."
- Romans 6:9: "We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him."
- Romans 8:34: "Christ Jesus who died—
  more than that, who was raised to life—is
  at the right hand of God and is also
  interceding for us."
- Romans 6:8-11:"The death he died, he died to sin once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God. In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus."
- Luke 24:6-7: "Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee: 'The Son of Man must be delivered over to the hands of sinners, be crucified and on the third day be raised again."

- Mark 15:32: "Let this Messiah, this king of Israel, come down now from the cross, that we may see and believe.' Those crucified with him also heaped insults on him."
- Romans 6:5-6: "For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly also be united with him in a resurrection like his. For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body ruled by sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin."
- Luke 9:23: "Then he said to them all:
   Whoever wants to be my disciple must
   deny themselves and take up their cross
   daily and follow me."
- Hebrews 12:2: "Fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith."
- 1 Corinthians 1:18: "For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God."
- Hebrews 12:2: "For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God."
