At the funeral of a young man who died in a mountain climbing accident, the pastor said in his homily, "We must see what has happened as God's will!" At that, the father of the young man stood and shouted, "NO NO NOT it was not God's will! When my son died, God was the first one who cried."

In a televised discussion between a Christian apologist and an avowed atheist, the Christian was stymied when asked, "If an all-powerful and loving God is in control of what happens in this world, then why is there so much suffering?"

POWER = control... LOVE = freedom (w benefits and consequences)

We will get back to that...

The Heart has 4 chambers. 2 intake 2 return - atrium / – ventricle

- Storge empathy bond. Parent / child, Mother/ infant
- Philia friendship bond.
- Eros romantic love.
- Agape unconditional "God" love.

Love gives, trust is giving, guarding is protecting.
