The heart is a muscular organ about the size of a fist, located just behind and slightly left of the breastbone. The heart pumps blood through the network of arteries and veins called the cardiovascular system.

The heart has four chambers:

- The right atrium receives blood from the veins and pumps it to the right ventricle.
- The right ventricle receives blood from the right atrium and pumps it to the lungs, where it is loaded with oxygen.
- The left atrium receives oxygenated blood from the lungs and pumps it to the left ventricle.
- The left ventricle (the strongest chamber) pumps oxygen-rich blood to the rest of the body. The left ventricle's vigorous contractions create our blood pressure.

The coronary arteries run along the surface of the heart and provide oxygen-rich blood to the heart muscle. A web of nerve tissue also runs through the heart, conducting the complex signals that govern contraction and relaxation. Surrounding the heart is a sac called the pericardium.

- 4. pursues God with absolute priority (says no; God is first, God is best)

3 causes of a Broken Heart:

1. A heart broken by betrayal.

⁴ My guilt has overwhelmed me like a burden too heavy to bear.

⁶ I am bowed down and brought very low; all day long I go about mourning.

⁸ I am feeble and utterly crushed; I groan in anguish of heart.

Mt 1:18 - Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be pregnant through the Holy Spirit. ¹⁹ Because Joseph her husband was faithful to the law, and yet did not want to expose her to public disgrace, he had in mind to divorce her quietly.

In this case Joseph thought his love had betrayed him. Betrayal in love is probably the most familiar form of broken heart to us.

What is unusual about this case is that Joseph is wrong, Mary hasn't betrayed him.

2. Broken by malfunction / improper operation -

- a. Unthankful Ness or gratitude?
- b. doubt and unbelief or trust and obedience
- c. sanctioning sin hunger for holiness

In a televised discussion between a Christian apologist and an avowed atheist, the Christian was stymied when asked, "If an all-powerful and loving God is in control of what happens in this world, then why is there so much suffering?"

POWER = control... LOVE = freedom (w benefits and consequences)
