Rom 5:1 - we have peace with God... And we boast in the hope of the glory of God. ... we also glory in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance; perseverance, character; and character, hope.

Rom 8:18 -I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us.

In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. 27 And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God. And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

- 1. Bitterness is like drinking poison and hoping the other person gets sick.
- 2. Forgiveness does not passively ignore, excuse, or sanction the offense, it merely proclaims that you are lo longer willing to be the victim.
